

Restricted Access Vehicle (RAV) Classes

Class 1 RAVs

Regulation 190 of the *Road Traffic (Vehicles) Regulations 2014* defines a *Class 1 vehicle* as one that by itself or together with its load, exceeds a prescribed mass or dimension limit and it is:

- a special purpose vehicle; or
- an agricultural machine or agricultural implement; or
- carrying, or designed to carry, a large indivisible item;

But it is *not* a road train, B-Double or carrying a multi-modal freight container.



Class 2 RAVs








Section 38 of the *Road Traffic (Vehicles) Act 2012* defines a *complying restricted access vehicle* as a vehicle that complies with all prescribed mass and dimension limits and is prescribed as a *Class 2 vehicle* under Regulation 203 of the *Road Traffic (Vehicles) Regulations 2014*. A *Class 2 vehicle* includes:

- a Controlled Access Bus; and
- a B-Double; and
- a Road Train; and
- a Livestock Carrier; and
- a multi deck Car Carrier.

B-Double (Statutory Mass Limits)	
B-Triple (Statutory Mass Limits)	
A-Triple Road Train (Statutory Mass Limits)	
AAB-Quad Road Train (Statutory Mass Limits)	
Livestock Carrier (height may exceed 4.3 m but must not exceed 4.6 m)	
Multi Deck Car Carrier (exceeds 19 m in length and may exceed 4.3 m in height but not exceed 4.6 m)	
Controlled Access Bus (exceeds 12.5 m but not 14.5 m)	

Class 3 RAVs

Regulation 190 of the *Road Traffic (Vehicles) Regulations 2014* defines a *Class 3 vehicle* as one that exceeds a prescribed dimension and/or mass limit and is not a *Class 1 vehicle* or *Class 2 vehicle*.

Truck towing a Dog Trailer (over 42.5 t GCM)	
B-Double (Concessional Mass Limits)	
B-Triple (Concessional Mass Limits)	
A-Triple Road Train (Concessional Mass Limits)	
AAB Quad Road Train (Concessional Mass Limits)	
A-Double Road Train or B-Double carrying a large indivisible load	
A-Double Road Train carrying over-width baled hay or wool
