Construction Update

February 2026

Reid Highway Interchanges Project

Altone Road and Drumpellier Drive / Daviot Road

Temporary roundabout at Drumpellier Drive / Daviot Road

The temporary roundabout at the Drumpellier Drive / Daviot Road intersection is planned to become operational from late February.

To safely implement the temporary roundabout, a weekend closure of Drumpellier Drive and Daviot Road will be required. Confirmed dates and detour information will be provided closer to the time.

During the closure, crews will complete line marking, barrier adjustments and install new signage. Reid Highway will remain open to traffic with lane closures in place.

Once the roundabout is operational, the existing traffic signals will be permanently removed. We encourage you to plan ahead to allow for additional travel time as some travel delays are anticipated once the roundabout is operational, particularly during peak periods.

What's happening on site

Construction is continuing on the new on and off ramps and bridge embankments, and to prepare for upcoming traffic changes. Planned activities for February include:

Reid Highway

- Demolition of the existing eastbound lane (west of Altone Road).
- Intermittent night works to carry out verge widening and temporary pavement construction along Reid Highway.

Altone Road

- Finishing works on the newly constructed road sections at the Altone Road intersection – including kerbing, line marking and barrier installation.
- Asphaltting works for the new on and off ramps located north of the intersection.
- Demolition of the Altone Road median south of Reid Highway.
- Vegetation clearing and construction of on and off ramps south of Reid Highway.

Drumpellier Drive / Daviot Road

- Excavation works commencing for the new bridge footings.
- Construction of drainage north of the intersection.
- Construction continuing for the future on and off ramps.

These works may generate some dust, noise and vibration. Monitoring is in place to ensure activities are managed in accordance with approved management plans and the City of Swan's noise requirements.

Recent traffic changes

The eastbound lanes of Reid Highway, west of Altone Road, have been shifted south of their previous alignment. This change allows demolition of the old roadway to safely commence.

Altone Road, north of Reid Highway, has also reopened under a new traffic alignment. While the same number of lanes are available, lane capacity is reduced, which may result in some delays during peak periods.

Temporary traffic management will be in place, and road users are asked to take extra care while adjusting to the new traffic conditions.

Upcoming traffic changes

As construction continues, traffic arrangements will continue to change, to open new work areas while keeping traffic on Reid Highway and local roads moving. This includes a speed limit reduction to 60km/h along Reid Highway for the entire length of the project from late February.

Changes to alignment of Altone Road (south)

In the coming months, the northbound lane of Altone Road will shift east to run alongside the southbound lane. Traffic will be reduced to a single lane through this section before rejoining at the existing Reid Highway / Altone Road intersection.

This change allows construction of the future road alignment to begin in the area currently occupied by the western lane.

A short-term closure of Altone Road between Reid Highway and Small Street will be required to implement this change. Confirmed dates and detour details will be shared closer to the time.

Thorburn Avenue / Altone Road intersection

When the south Altone alignment shifts, the Thorburn Avenue intersection will be reconfigured to operate as left-in, left-out only.

This temporary arrangement is needed to support the new traffic layout and is expected to remain in place until around mid-2027.

Alternative access to Altone Road will also be available via Small Street.

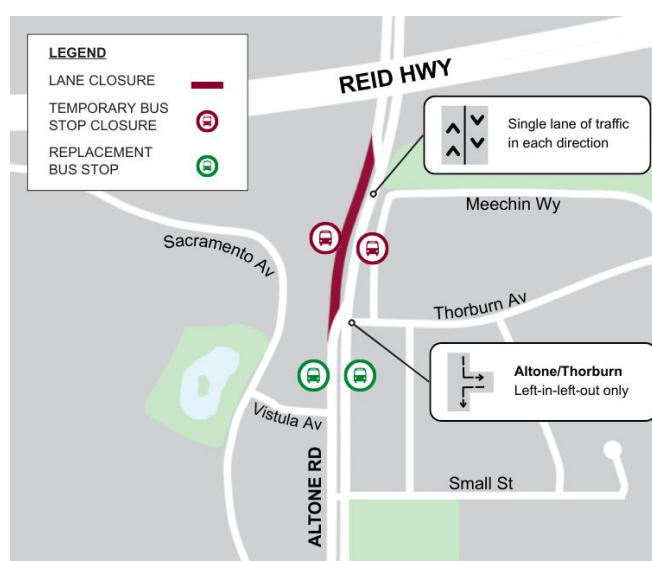
Bus stop relocations along Altone Road

Bus stops 15668 and 15657, located south of Reid Highway, will be temporarily relocated approximately 200 metres further south.

Temporary bus stops will be built in advance so services can continue operating safely during construction. Signage will be installed at the current bus stop locations to guide passengers.

Permanent bus stops will be reinstated near their existing locations towards the end of the project.
