



## Albany Highway, Olga Road and Kelvin Road: Intersection Upgrade

The busy intersection of Albany Highway, Olga Road and Kelvin Road, in Maddington, is being upgraded to improve traffic flow and enhance safety for road users and pedestrians.

To prepare the site for this important project, the Water Corporation has already relocated two large water mains under Albany Highway.

Over the next six months, Western Power, ATCO Gas and telecommunications providers will be completing further service relocations, requiring traffic management and after hours works.

Construction works are expected to get underway at the intersection before the end of 2026 and be completed in 2027.

This project is funded by the State Government.

### Project Scope

Albany Highway will be widened to double the number of traffic lanes on each approach to the intersection, significantly improving capacity and traffic flow.

This will provide two lanes for motorists travelling straight through on Albany Highway, as well as new left and right-turn pockets for traffic turning into Olga Road and Kelvin Road.

A new solid median will also be installed on Albany Highway, within the vicinity of the intersection, to improve safety by eliminating right-turn movements across multiple lanes of traffic.

To improve safety and connectivity for pedestrians, the median islands will also be widened to provide refuge while crossing and

a new footpath will be constructed along Albany Highway.

Line-marking, lighting and drainage will also be upgraded as part of the project.
