



Ennis Avenue and Dixon Road: Intersection Improvements

We are upgrading the busy intersection of Ennis Avenue and Dixon Road, in the City of Rockingham, to improve road user safety.

This \$2 million project is funded under the State Government's Black Spot program.

A new free-flow turn pocket and acceleration lane will replace the existing give-way intersection for traffic turning from Dixon Road westbound to Ennis Avenue southbound. This treatment is designed to eliminate the high number of severe right-angle crashes that occur at this junction.

This work is expected to start in April and be finished by mid-2024.

What to expect during construction

While most of the construction will be completed during the day, some nightworks may be required to avoid traffic congestion during busy periods.

Every effort will be made to keep noise to a minimum and any after hours work will be undertaken in accordance with a Noise Management Plan, approved by the City of Rockingham.

There will also be lane closures, speed reductions and occasional detours to allow the work to be completed safely.
