



In order to obtain the 53.5 metre Bindoon Hill Special Assistance Permit, participating 53.5 metre Triple Road Trains must meet all the eligibility requirements and provide evidence of such to Main Roads Heavy Vehicle Services. The 53.5 metre Bindoon Hill Special Assistance Permit Eligibility & Supporting Evidence Checklist is available on our website and must be submitted with your permit application.

You must also be an accredited Operator with Main Roads WA. If you do not have an Operator Number, please complete the Restricted Access Vehicle Operator Registration form, available on our website. Please ensure that all prime movers listed on this permit application have been registered with Main Roads. To register, please complete an Application to List or Update a Vehicle form for each prime mover, available on our website.

Eligibility Requirements

Please check the box to confirm that all supporting evidence has been provided to address the eligibility criteria below.

1. The prime mover must be fitted with an engine that meets the emission standards specified in the Vehicle Standard (Australian Design Rule 80/03 - Emission Control for Heavy Vehicles) 2006 (equivalent to Euro 5 Standards).
2. The prime mover must have a minimum 550 hp engine power.
3. The prime mover must be fitted with an Antilock Braking System (ABS) or an Electronic Braking System (EBS) and supply a CAN / TEBS brake application signal.
4. The semi-trailers must be fitted with a Trailer Electronic Braking System (TEBS), with a fully functional Rollover Stability System (RSS) and a compatible CAN bus connection linking all semi-trailers.
5. The prime movers must be fitted with a driver fatigue and distraction monitoring system, with appropriate governance in place to ensure events are managed effectively.
6. The prime mover must be installed with an in-vehicle telematics unit and Main Roads Heavy Vehicle Services (HVS) must be provided direct access to the telematics monitoring system to view speed and position records.
7. The prime mover must be fitted with and utilise an auxiliary braking system when descending the hill. Drivers must be familiar with the operation of the particular auxiliary braking system, with training records provided to HVS.
8. Drivers must have a minimum of 3 years of experience in driving road trains and a good driving record. A National Police Clearance is required to confirm the driver does not have any serious traffic convictions before they are approved on the permit. The operator must continue to report any driving convictions once a driver has been approved.
9. At least one forward facing camera must be mounted on the prime mover and operate in accordance with the Restricted Access Vehicle Video Recording Requirements, available on the Specific Access Permits page on the Main Roads website.

Your personal details will not be disclosed to any other third party without your consent unless required to do so by law or for purposes mentioned in the Information Privacy Act 2009.
