

53.5 metre Bindoon Hill Special Assistance Permit Eligibility & Supporting Evidence Checklist

The 53.5 metre Bindoon Hill Special Assistance Permit is available to WA Heavy Vehicle Accredited Operators to operate a Triple Road Train Combination, on Great Northern Highway between Muchea and Wubin, subject to meeting all the eligibility criteria and supporting evidence requirements in the following table.
