Falls Road Bridge Replacement and Brooking Road Bridge, Parkerville

Main Roads will be completing bridge works in Parkerville in the second half of 2026, to improve local road connections and bushfire safety.

From mid-year, work will start on replacing the existing 126-year-old timber bridge on Falls Road with a new concrete culvert crossing over Jane Brook.

A new culvert bridge and footpaths will also be constructed over Jane Brook, to prepare for the Shire of Mundaring's extension of Brooking Road from Owen Road to Richardson Road. The Brooking Road extension will help reduce traffic on the parallel route of Roland Road, Byfield Road and Seaborne Street and provide a more direct route for residents and emergency services.

This \$2.2 million project is funded by the Australian Government's Safer Local Roads and Infrastructure Program, the WA Government and the Shire of Mundaring.

What to expect during construction

The majority of construction activity is expected to be undertaken Monday to Saturday, between 7am and 5pm, and take about six months to complete.

A section of Falls Road will need to be closed for the existing bridge to be demolished and reconstructed, requiring detours for road users and pedestrians.

Local access will be maintained to residential properties. Any road closures and detours required will be advertised in advance.
