



## Wanneroo Road and East Road Intersection Upgrade

The busy intersection of Wanneroo Road and East Road, on the border of Pearsall and Hocking, is being upgraded to improve safety and reduce traffic delays.

This election commitment will realign Wanneroo Road's southbound carriageway to the west, allowing the give way line on East Road to be brought forward. This will significantly improve intersection sight lines and visibility for road users and pedestrians.

It will also include:

- A dedicated new left-turn lane on East Road, reducing congestion for cars and buses.
- A modified intersection layout in the Wanneroo Road median, with splitter islands to separate turning traffic.
- An extended right-turn pocket on Wanneroo Road northbound into East Road.
- Upgraded paths and new pedestrian crossings north and south of the intersection,

improving connections and accessibility to upgraded bus stops.

This \$4.2 million project is funded by the State Government to improve safety.

In the five-year period to December 2025, 16 crashes were reported at this intersection. Most of these occurred during a right-turn or were the result of a rear-end collision and one injured a pedestrian.

### What to expect during construction

From mid-2026, after hours service relocations will get underway to prepare the site. This includes work by Western Power to relocate existing streetlights and install new poles.

Roadworks will start before the end of the year and be completed in early 2027.

Due to high traffic volumes on Wanneroo Road, the majority of work required to complete this

intersection upgrade, including service relocations, will be undertaken after hours. Every effort will be made to minimise disruption to nearby residents.

Road users should expect lane closures, speed reductions and traffic management. Any road closures and detours will be advertised in advance.
