We are committed to handling all personal and sensitive information securely and responsibly, ensuring individuals' privacy is protected

Intent

- Collect only personal and sensitive information that is fair and reasonably necessary for the performance of our functions.
- Use and disclose personal information only for its primary purpose, unless required or where is lawful, authorised, consented or reasonably expected or otherwise permitted
- Apply safeguards to protect personal information from misuse, loss, unauthorised access, modification or disclosure.
- Maintain accurate, relevant and up-to-date personal information.
- Ensure personal information is retained, de-identified or disposed of in accordance with approved requirements.
- Limit the use of unique identifiers and disclose them only where lawful and necessary.
- Respond promptly and appropriately to suspected or actual privacy breaches.

Objectives

- Ensure personal and sensitive information is managed in a lawful, ethical and accountable manner in accordance with our Privacy Framework
- Ensure that our partners understand their and our privacy obligations.
- Clearly assign responsibility and accountability for privacy governance.
- Align privacy practices with legislative, regulatory and whole-of-government requirements.
- Promote transparency in how we collect, use and disclose personal information.
- Support consistent and responsible information handling across the organisation.
- Strengthen public trust in our ability to manage information and data.
- Provide individuals with access to their information, and enable corrections, subject to legal limitations.
- Support awareness and capability in privacy obligations and good information handling practices.
