2024 Community Perceptions Summary Report







Methodology

A survey was conducted with a random sample of 1,414 members of the public across Western Australia.

An online survey achieved **n=1,221** completed interviews, using Q&A's quality accredited WA online panel. In addition, **n=193** social media interviews were conducted to achieve the target sample of n=100 responses per region. The same survey was used for both online and social media. Some responses were removed in the data cleaning process.

All fieldwork was conducted from 26 February to 24 March 2024.

Soft quotas were set by age, gender and region. In line with previous surveys, the data was weighted by age, gender and region to reflect 2016 ABS Census statistics.

The **total sample** of **1,414** provides a maximum margin of error of ± 2.6% at the 95% confidence interval.

The response rate for the social media component was **17%** and approximately **15%** for online.

Question wording and analysis of data for KPI performance reporting remained entirely consistent with previous years.



KPI Ratings | % Total Okay, Good and Excellent











After trending upwards for the past three years, South West ratings for road safety have declined in 2024.





Road Maintenance by Region

Conversely, the Wheatbelt and South West decreased for road maintenance (the latter to its lowest level since survey inception), and in the case of the South West has in all likelihood impacted its overall performance KPI rating.








Detailed Performance Ratings



Detailed performance measures remain stable year on year

Slight uplifts in roadsides/verges being well maintained and road surface conditions are likely contributing to road maintenance increases seen in KPI measures this year.
