Reid Highway Interchanges Project

Altone Road and Drumpellier Drive / Daviot Road

Major milestone ahead with bridge beam lifts set to begin

Construction of the Reid Highway Interchanges Project continues to make strong progress, with the project preparing for the installation of bridge beams at the future Drumpellier Drive / Daviot Road interchange.

Over recent weeks, precast bridge beams have arrived on site, where crews are preparing them for installation.

In late August, specialist cranes will begin lifting the bridge beams into place. Lifting activities will begin on the northern half of the bridge, closest to Drumpellier Drive, before shifting to the southern side.

Upcoming traffic impacts

Reid Highway alignment

In late August, the alignment of Reid Highway will shift north between the Drumpellier Drive / Daviot Road temporary roundabout and Arthur Street Bridge.

This change will provide the space needed for crews to complete bridge beam installation and enable construction of the permanent Reid Highway westbound carriageway.

To safely implement the new alignment, crews will work continuously over the weekend from **7pm Friday 28 August to 10pm Sunday 30 August**.

During this period, traffic on Reid Highway will be reduced to a single lane in each direction through the work area. Some delays may be expected.

Daviot Road & Altone Road

Over the coming months, traffic alignments on Daviot Road and Altone Road (south of Reid Highway) will change to open up new work areas for construction.

Temporary overnight road closures will be required to safely implement these new alignments. Further information, including confirmed timing, traffic management arrangements and detour routes, will be shared closer to the works.

What's happening on site

Drumpellier Drive / Daviot Road interchange

- Once the bridge beams are installed, crews will begin constructing the bridge deck, including installation of permanent formwork, reinforcement and concrete.
- Construction of the permanent Reid Highway westbound carriageway is underway. Following the Reid Highway traffic alignment change in late August, crews will remove and reconstruct the pavement between the temporary roundabout and Arthur Street Bridge.
- Construction of the dedicated left-turn pocket into Luminous Boulevard and associated drainage and service installation works has commenced and will continue through October.
- Painting of the bridge abutment walls is scheduled to commence in August and will continue into September. The panels will feature blue tones to complement the nearby Arthur Street Bridge and will include an anti-graffiti coating.
- Installation of steel noise wall posts commenced along Daviot Road in August and will continue along Drumpellier Drive during September. Noise wall panel fabrication is now well underway, with panels pre-cast locally in Herne Hill.

Altone Road interchange

- Importation of material for the bridge embankments is continuing, while crews progress pavement construction on the bridge approaches and future westbound on-and off-ramps. Asphalt works are scheduled to commence in September.
- Construction of the new northbound lanes on Altone Road will commence following completion of the adjacent noise wall.
- Construction of the Principal Shared Path underpass south-east of the interchange is progressing, with mechanically stabilised earth (MSE) wall panels installed and deck construction underway.
- Construction of the shared path footbridge south-west of the interchange is continuing, including installation of MSE wall panels and blockwork retaining walls.
- Preparation works are also underway ahead of the delivery of bridge beams, scheduled to commence from mid-September.

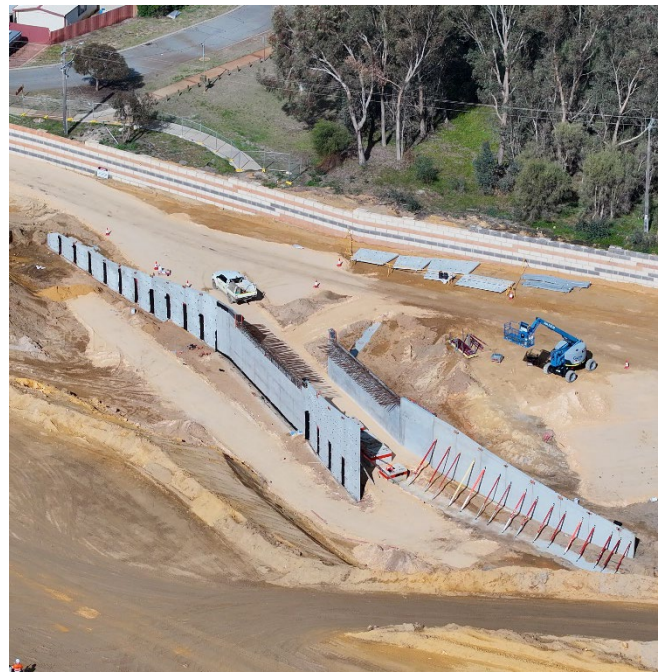

Students help shape future underpass artwork

Students from Caversham Valley Primary School recently took part in a series of art workshops to help design a mural for one of the project's new Principal Shared Path (PSP) underpasses.

Western Australian artist Paula Hart worked with students from Years 1 to 6 to create illustrations inspired by the local environment, including native plants, animals and landscapes.

Paula will combine elements of the students' drawings into a single mural, which will feature within the new arched underpass beneath Daviot Road.

The underpass forms part of the project's upgraded shared path network, which will provide uninterrupted pedestrian and cyclist access between West Swan Road and Malaga Drive.

Street and path lighting installation

The project will install new street light poles along Reid Highway, adjoining local roads and shared paths.

Since June, crews have progressively installed light poles along sections of Reid Highway and Drumpellier Drive, with many now operational.

Some newly installed lights may remain switched off for a period after installation. This is expected, as construction is being completed in stages and some underground conduits and electrical connections cannot be completed until surrounding roadworks are complete.
