



Reid Highway Interchanges Project

Altone Road and Drumpellier Drive / Daviot Road

This update contains information regarding the current and future works happening on the Reid Highway Interchanges project. Information in this update is current as of September 2025 and is subject to change. For the most recent updates visit the Main Roads Reid Highway Interchanges website.

Clearing works to begin in late September

We are planning to commence vegetation clearing works for the Reid Highway Interchanges Project from late-September 2025. These works will be staged, starting on the north side of the Reid Highway / Altone Road intersection.

As we are working in a highly constrained area, clearing is an essential step to allow for the new infrastructure upgrades to be built in this area. These upgrades include bridges, ramps, Principal Shared Path (PSP) connections and noise walls.

We are committed to minimising clearing wherever possible and will be working on a landscaping and replanting strategy for the project. We will provide more information as this progresses.

Works will involve the use of standard construction machinery and equipment. While some noise is unavoidable, it will be managed in line with environmental requirements. To minimise dust impacts, the project will use a range of controls including water carts and sprays, limiting vehicle speeds and applying dust suppressants. Regular monitoring will ensure dust remains within safe limits.

After hours works on Reid Highway and surrounding intersections

From mid-September, after hours works will take place along Reid Highway to prepare for upcoming construction. Activities will include installing temporary barriers and removing existing wire-rope barriers and kerb. Around both the Reid Highway / Altone Road and Drumpellier Drive / Daviot Road intersections, service location works will also be completed after hours, which requires partial lane closures to safely complete these works.

The temporary barriers will remain in place for the duration of the project to support construction staging and maintain safe separation between traffic and the work zone. These early works will enable clearing and further construction activities to commence safely.

- **Start date:** Mid-September 2025
- **Duration:** Approximately four weeks
- **Work hours:** Sunday to Thursday, 7pm to 7am

Some noise and vibration may be expected; however, this will be managed in line with approved management plans and with the City of Swan's noise requirements.

Site compound establishment works

From early September, we will begin to establish the main site compound on the north-eastern corner of the Reid Highway and Drumpellier Drive / Daviot Road intersection.

- **Start date:** Early September 2025
- **Work hours:** Weekdays, 7am to 5pm
- **Duration:** Approximately four weeks
- **Activities:** Topsoil removal, hardstand construction, site setup (buildings and services).

The site facilities, which include offices, crib rooms, toilets and parking, will remain in place until the project is completed. To minimise impacts to nearby residents, access into the area will be via Drumpellier Drive. However, minor changes to the PSP will be required, including the installation of give way signs where it intersects with the compound entry/exit.

After the main site compound has been established, you may notice an increase in activity in the area, including on weekends and out-of-hours. We understand this may cause some inconvenience to nearby residents and every effort will be made to reduce impacts where possible.

An additional site office will also be established near the Altone Road intersection. More details will be shared once the location is confirmed.

Detours for local paths

Planning is underway for temporary detours to local path networks, including the Principal Shared Path (PSP), to allow construction to commence in these areas while ensuring safe access for pedestrians and cyclists. While details are still being confirmed, detours will be required as works progress in the coming months.

Information on upcoming detours, including maps and timing, will be shared on the project webpage and in future updates. We encourage path users to stay informed by visiting the project webpage and subscribing to project updates.
