



# **Canning Bridge Bus Interchange and Foreshore Precinct**



Planning is underway for a new Canning Bridge Bus Interchange to provide more bus stands, new entries, better pedestrian access, more station facilities, direct connectivity for bus and train passengers and new Principal Shared Path (PSP) connections.

A development contract was awarded to GHD Pty Ltd in May 2024 to develop a preliminary design for the project, which will see a dedicated new facility built over the train station and Kwinana Freeway, replacing the existing bus station on Canning Highway.

# **Key features**



**Increased capacity:** 12 active bus stands with weather protection, seating and service information.



**Passenger amenity and access:** Public toilets, ticketing services, lifts, stairs, bicycle parking shelters and bicycle u-rails.



**Pedestrian and cycle access:** Underpasses and bridges to eliminate the need for riders and walkers to cross busy roads, and create safer connections between the station, residential areas and the foreshore.



**Safety and security:** Preliminary design adopts Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CPTED) principles, including open spaces supporting passive surveillance.



**Traffic efficiency:** An upgrade to the Canning Highway on-ramp at Kwinana Freeway northbound, with Smart Freeway ramp metering.



**Future planning:** Potential integration with the State Government's future ferry terminal on the Canning River foreshore.



**Public spaces:** Exploring ways to enhance the precinct, especially the Canning River foreshore.
