CONSTRUCTION UPDATE OCTOBER 2025









Reid Highway Interchanges Project **Altone Road and Drumpellier Drive / Daviot Road**

Clearing works continuing

Vegetation clearing works is progressing in a staged approach through to early December, starting north of the Reid Highway and Altone Road intersection. As clearing works are completed in each area, we will begin importing materials required to build the temporary traffic diversions, and ramps.

With this stage of works, nearby residents and road users may notice an increase in truck movements around the project area as materials are delivered.

Dust, noise and vibration monitoring are now in place across the project site so we can closely monitor work impacts. Dust and noise will be managed through approved controls, including water carts, sprays and reduced vehicle speeds.

After hours works on Reid Highway

Night works will continue in October to install temporary barriers and remove existing wire-rope barriers and kerbing along Reid Highway and nearby roads. From mid-October, temporary pavement works will also begin in the highway median. These barriers and pavement will provide safe construction areas and support traffic staging throughout the project.













We will continue working between 7pm and 7am, from Sundays to Thursdays.

Some noise and vibration may be expected throughout these works; however, this will be managed in line with approved management plans and the City of Swan's noise requirements.

New traffic conditions on Reid Highway

From early October, the speed limit on Reid Highway between Altone Road and Drumpellier Drive / Daviot Road will be reduced to 80 km/h for the duration of the project. New speed signage has been installed to reflect this change.

As the safety of workers, road users, pedestrians and cyclists remain the project's highest priority, this change is necessary due to altered traffic conditions and the presence of workers on site.

As we are working within a constrained space, the existing emergency stopping bays and lanes will also be closed. In the event of any traffic incidents, we will be actively monitoring conditions and respond quickly to support emergency services and manage traffic safely and efficiently.

We urge all road users to adhere to the new speed limits and take caution while driving through changed traffic conditions in the area.

Drumpellier Drive site facilities



Construction of site facilities on Drumpellier Drive is progressing well, with the compound expected to be operational by mid-October. The facilities will include offices, crib rooms, toilets and parking, and will remain in place until project completion.

To minimise impacts on nearby residents, vehicle access into the site will be from Drumpellier Drive only and will operate on a left-in/left-out basis.

A second site office is also planned near the Altone Road intersection, in the north-eastern corner of the site. More information will be provided when construction of the second site office is underway.

Principal Shared Path (PSP) and local path detours

To allow construction activities to be completed safely and enable future traffic switches, we will need to divert pedestrians and cyclists away from the PSP along Reid Highway and at Altone Road and Drumpellier Drive / Daviot Road.

To minimise disruptions to PSP and path users, long-term diversions will be implemented and will be in place until the project is complete. Approved detour routes will guide pedestrians and cyclists through the local road and path network.

While some of the routes are anticipated to increase travel time, several options were assessed to minimise impacts while ensuring safe connectivity. Minor improvement works will also take place along the detour routes including additional fencing and signage to support safe travel.













The first closure is proposed for a section of PSP along Reid Highway between west of Altone Road and west of Arthur Street Bridge, along with the Drumpellier Drive PSP south of Marshall Road. These closures are anticipated from late-October and are required to enable construction works to proceed and to keep pedestrians and cyclists safely separated from active work zones.

Subsequently, the Grandis Road underpass is anticipated to close from mid-November, to allow for ramp construction and underpass extension works. In addition, the pedestrian crossing on Altone Road will be shifted to the eastern side of the road, with temporary pavement installed to maintain safe access.

Additional path closures may be required as works progress and we will continue to provide updates and advance notice of any further changes. Please note that the timeframes to implement the above closures are not final and are subject to change.
