CBBI – My Say Survey

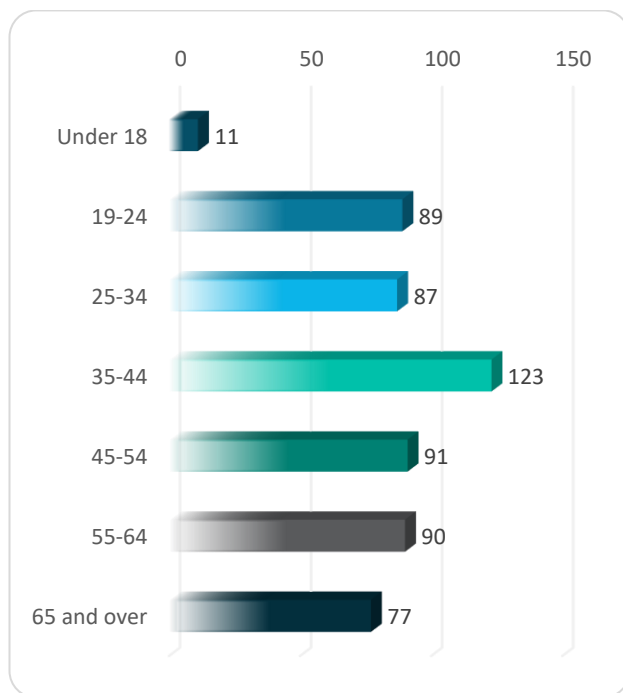
The Canning Bridge Bus Interchange (CBBI) project 'My Say' survey took place during September 2025. 562 people participated in the survey, responding to 11 questions on the preliminary design, particularly seeking ideas and input into the Como and Salter Point foreshores which are to be upgraded to compliment the interchange precinct.

Responders were also asked to provide comments on what they would like to see on the Canning River foreshores adjacent to the project and the design concept itself. These are currently being considered and collated.

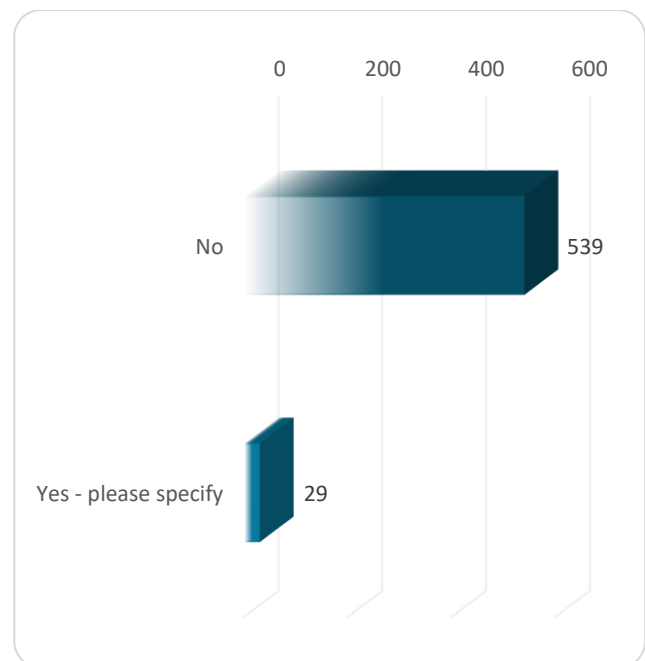
Over 2,000 people viewed multiple Project Pages, with more viewing photographs. Over 4,000 people visited at least one page on the project website.

Survey Question Analysis

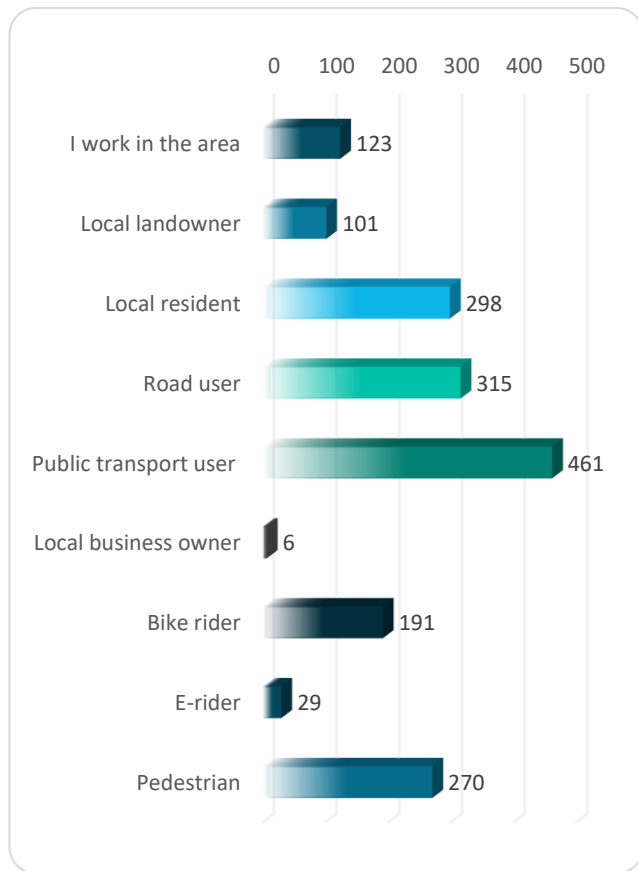
Question one: What is your age?



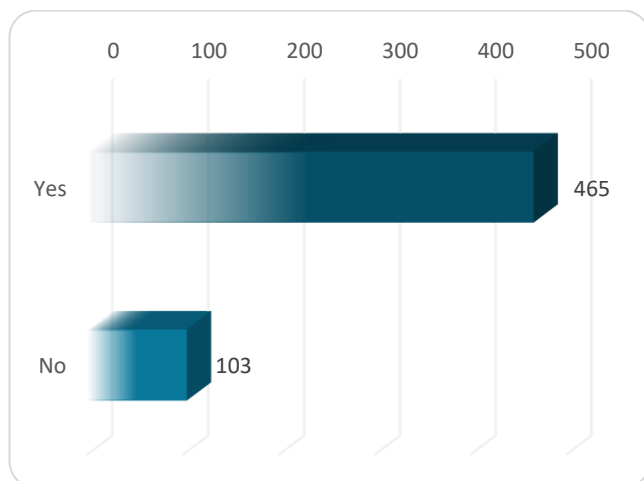
Question two: Do you have any accessibility requirements?



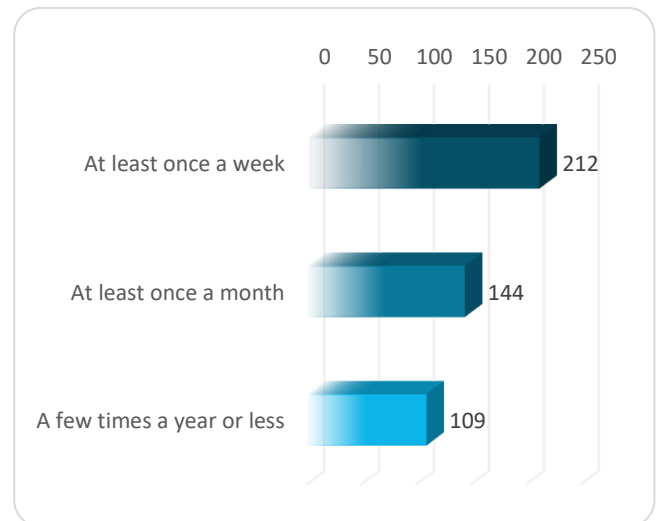
Question three: What is your interest in the project?



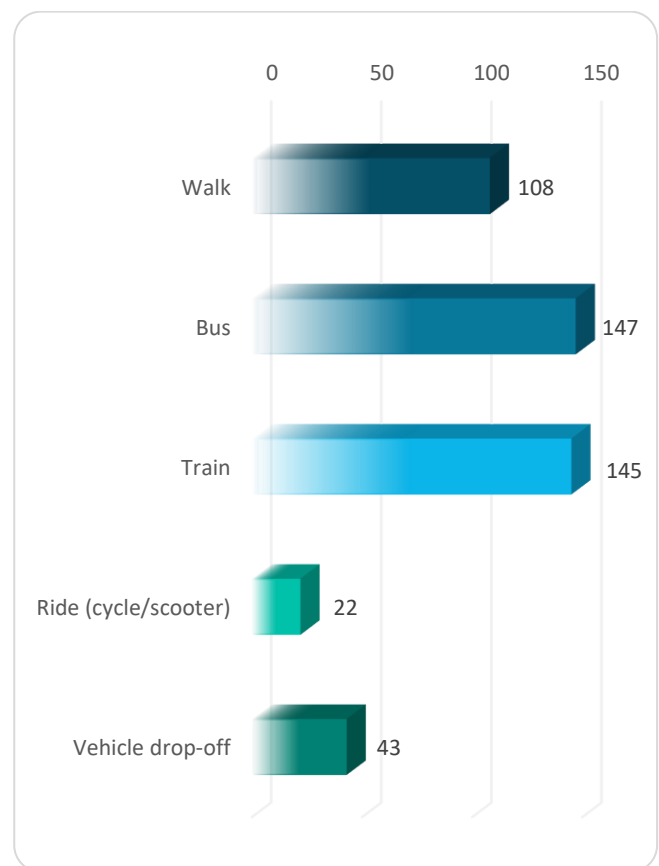
Question four: Do you currently access public transport via the Canning Bridge bus or train station?



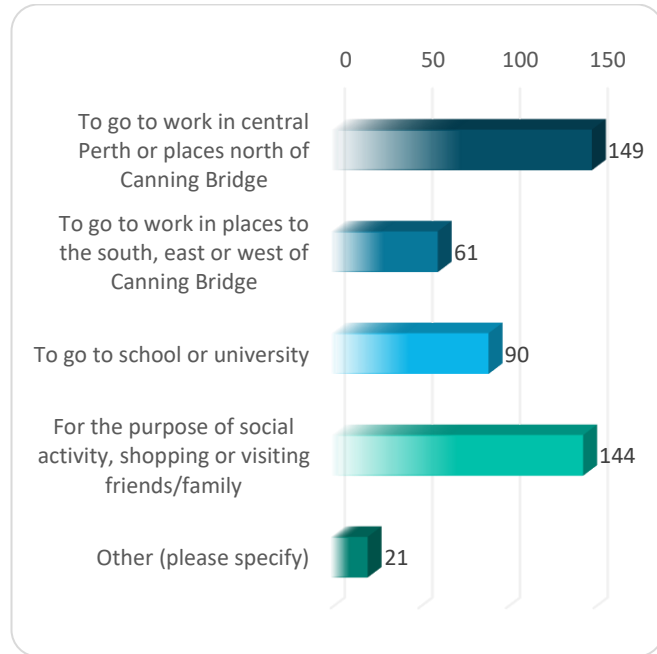
Question five: How often do you access Canning Bridge Station?



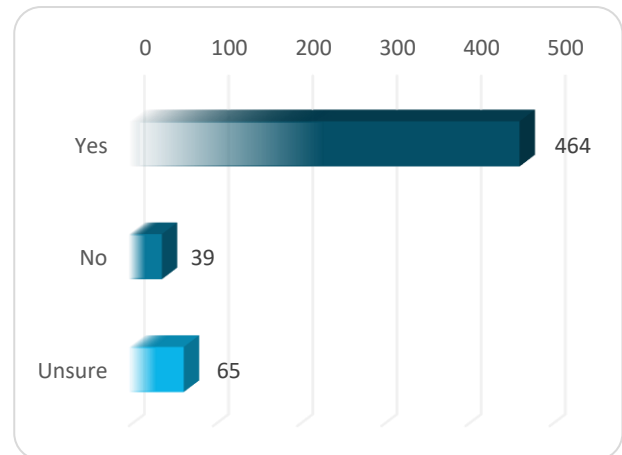
Question six: What is your usual mode of access to Canning Bridge bus or train station?



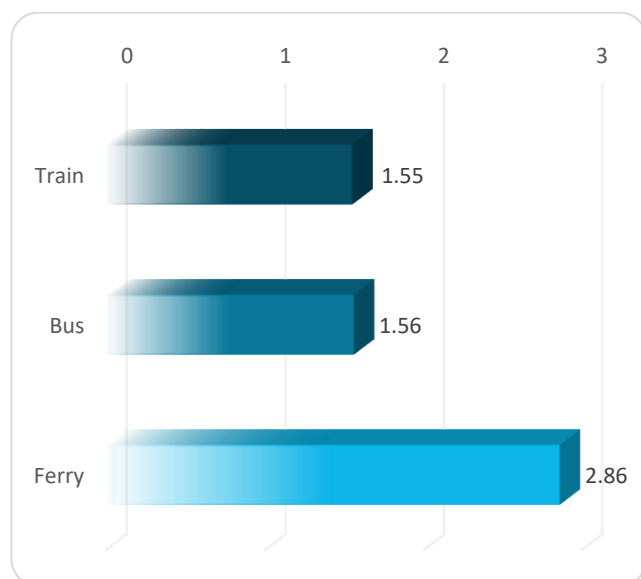
Question seven: What is usually the purpose of your trip when travelling via Canning Bridge Station?



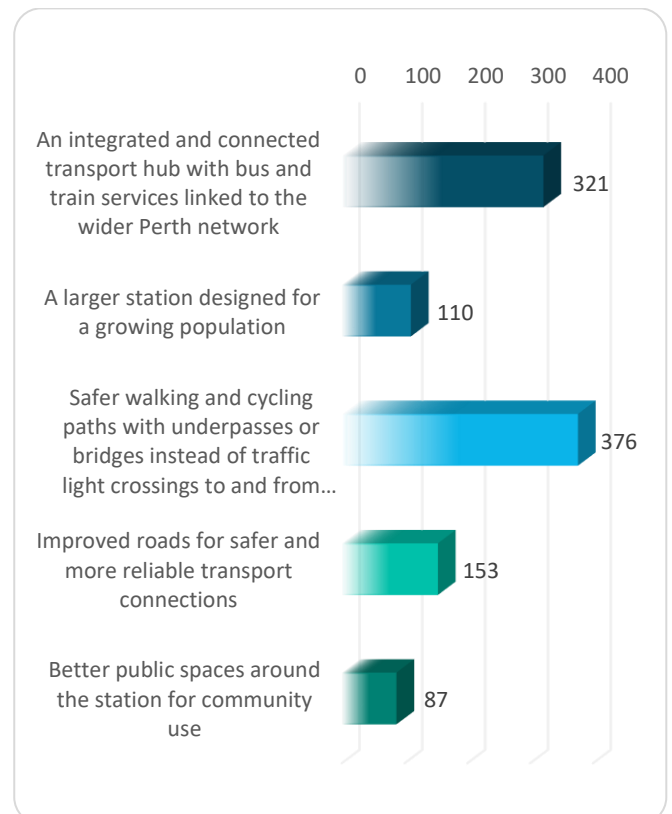
Question nine: If public transport to and from Canning Bridge Station was easier to access and more efficient, would you use it more often?



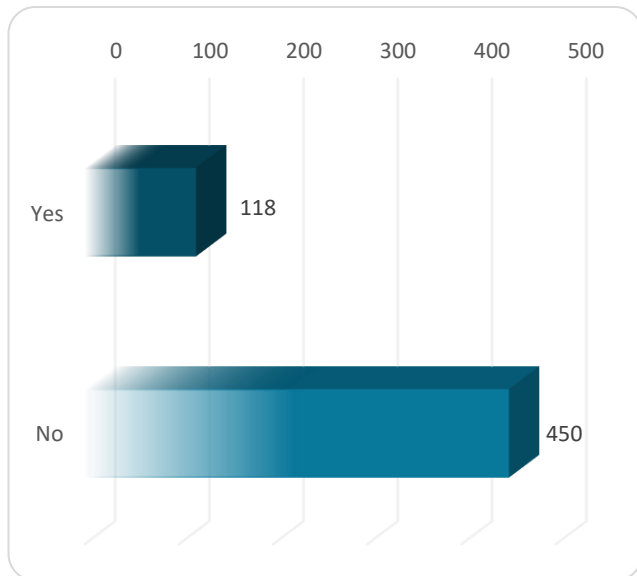
Question eight: Please rank the following public transport services in order of how frequently you use them, with 1 being the most frequent

Conclusion

While the comments are still being analysed and assessed, the evidence from the survey means it is reasonable to conclude that there is strong support for a fully functioning public transport interchange at Canning Bridge. Safety also features strongly with current users welcoming the removal of the current bus bays from Canning Highway and the provision of safer access to busses and trains as well as throughways to the river foreshore.
