


Morley Drive and Constance Street Intersection Upgrade and U-Turn Facility



Traffic flow and safety is set to be improved at the intersection of Morley Drive and Constance Street, on the border of Yokine and Nollamara.

The intersection will be modified to provide separation between vehicles turning right from Morley Drive and support the left-in, left out arrangement from both Constance Street approaches to Morley Drive.

This will be supported by a new, dedicated U-turn facility on Morley Drive, between Jason Street and Hillsborough Drive. This will give road users the opportunity to make a safe U-turn to head west on Morley Drive.

For safety reasons, the two existing pedestrian crossings on Morley Drive will

be relocated between Constance Street and Hillsborough Drive and reconstructed to current standards.

Work is expected to start before the end of the year and take approximately three months to complete.

What to expect during construction

The majority of construction work will be undertaken during the day, between 7am and 7pm Monday to Saturday.

Road users should expect lane closures and speed reductions on Morley Drive, between Constance Street and Hillsborough Drive, throughout the construction period.

The new U-turn facility will be constructed first, while the Constance Street intersection remains open. The median break at Constance Street will then be closed, restricting right turns from Morley

Drive. A detour will be in place during this time via Hillsborough Drive.

Road users, pedestrians and cyclists are reminded to take care through the worksite and follow directional signage at all times.

The design for this project has been carefully considered to protect as much vegetation as possible, although some clearing and pruning is required to make room for the road safety improvements.

Any mature trees removed for the road safety improvements will be replaced within the local area during future planting seasons. The location of new trees will be determined in consultation with the City of Stirling.
