Major traffic changes coming to Innaloo and Stirling

MAIN ROADS ASKS MOTORISTS TO PLAN AHEAD

The temporary Cedric Street southbound off-ramp to close on Friday, 14 November at 9pm

To progress critical works associated with the Stephenson Avenue Extension project, Main Roads has today announced the temporary southbound off-ramp at Cedric Street in Innaloo will be permanently closed from 9pm on Friday November 14.

The closure of the off-ramp is required to safely complete works on the new off-ramp being built at Stephenson Avenue.

Once the Cedric Street southbound off-ramp is closed, Main Roads will be working 24/7 to minimise the timeframe the ramp is closed and therefore disruption to traffic. Based on current schedules, the new permanent off-ramp at Stephenson Avenue will open in early December.

The closure of the Cedric Street southbound off-ramp means access to Innaloo, Stirling and surrounding areas will temporarily be via the following alternative routes until the new permanent Stephenson Avenue southbound off-ramp is operational:

- To access Innaloo and northern Stirling exit earlier at the Karrinyup Road southbound offramp.
- To access Osborne Park and southern Stirling exit later at the Hutton Street southbound off-ramp.


Access to the Stirling Station northern car park will be maintained via Cedric Street only, with no changes to exiting the car park.

Main Roads understands these changes may cause inconvenience and thanks the community for their patience while the works are undertaken.

Signage will be in place to support these changes, and we encourage people to allow additional time for their travel journey, especially during peak periods.
