

# South Western Highway and Vittoria Road Intersection Upgrade

Construction of a new roundabout at the intersection of South Western Highway and Vittoria Road is underway, which will significantly improve road safety, traffic flow and access at this key Picton location.

The new roundabout has been designed to reduce driver frustration, risk taking and crashes by:

- Providing a safer right-turn movement from Vittoria Road on to South Western Highway;
- Providing a dedicated left-turning lane onto South Western Highway from Vittoria Road;
- Reducing queuing and improving traffic efficiencies; and
- Providing a slower environment at the intersection.

The project also provides an opportunity to improve one of Bunbury's key entrances and support the Glen Iris community through a revegetation and landscaping program with native species that are present in the area.

## What's happening

A comprehensive program of pre-construction activities, including service relocations, have now been completed.

From now until the end of the year, road users will notice "off highway" works taking place. This is Stage One of construction, which includes the construction of new pavement without the need for road closures. Speed restrictions will be in place during this stage of works.

In January 2024, Stage Two of the roundabout's construction will commence. As part of this stage, the construction of new pavement will occur over the existing South Western Highway and Vittoria Road.

The following closures will be in effect, 24 hours a day, seven days a week, from 8 January until mid-May 2024:

- Vittoria Road will be closed in both directions between Erica Entrance and South Western Highway; and
- South Western Highway will be closed westbound from O'Connor Entrance to Dodson Road.
