#### **Planning and development**

- Planning activities to inform design development including:
  - Historical planning review.
  - Engineering, heritage and environmental studies.
  - Community and stakeholder engagement.
- Preparation of the Ultimate Design Concept: the long-term planning concept that caters for population growth and future traffic volumes up to the year 2051.
- Establish the land requirement boundary; the extent of land required to construct the corridor in the future, if funding becomes available.

- Planning Control Area to protect the corridor for future road development.
