

HMMS 5 Step Guide

Follow these five steps to ensure you are ready for the HMMS access arrangements 2018-19:

Register for HMMS

- The transport operator must register their vehicles with a registered Grain Receiver.

Confirm Vehicle Type

- A farmer or transport operator needs to identify the RAV combination being used to access the paddock and ensure it is not a higher category than the nearest RAV Network.

HMMS Road List

- A farmer or transport operator needs to submit the list of roads being used by the RAV between the paddock and the nearest road approved for RAV Network access to Main Roads using the HMMS Road List form. Submit now to avoid delays.

Main Roads Endorsement

- Main Roads will conduct a preliminary assessment of the nominated roads and provided the access is considered safe, endorse the HMMS Road List and return the list to the applicant. This endorsed HMMS Road List may be shared with other transport operators.

Commence Operating

- Now your vehicles are registered with a Grain Receiver, you have obtained a Main Roads endorsed HMMS Road List, you have familiarised yourself with the Business rules and access conditions, you are ready to start carting for the harvest season.
