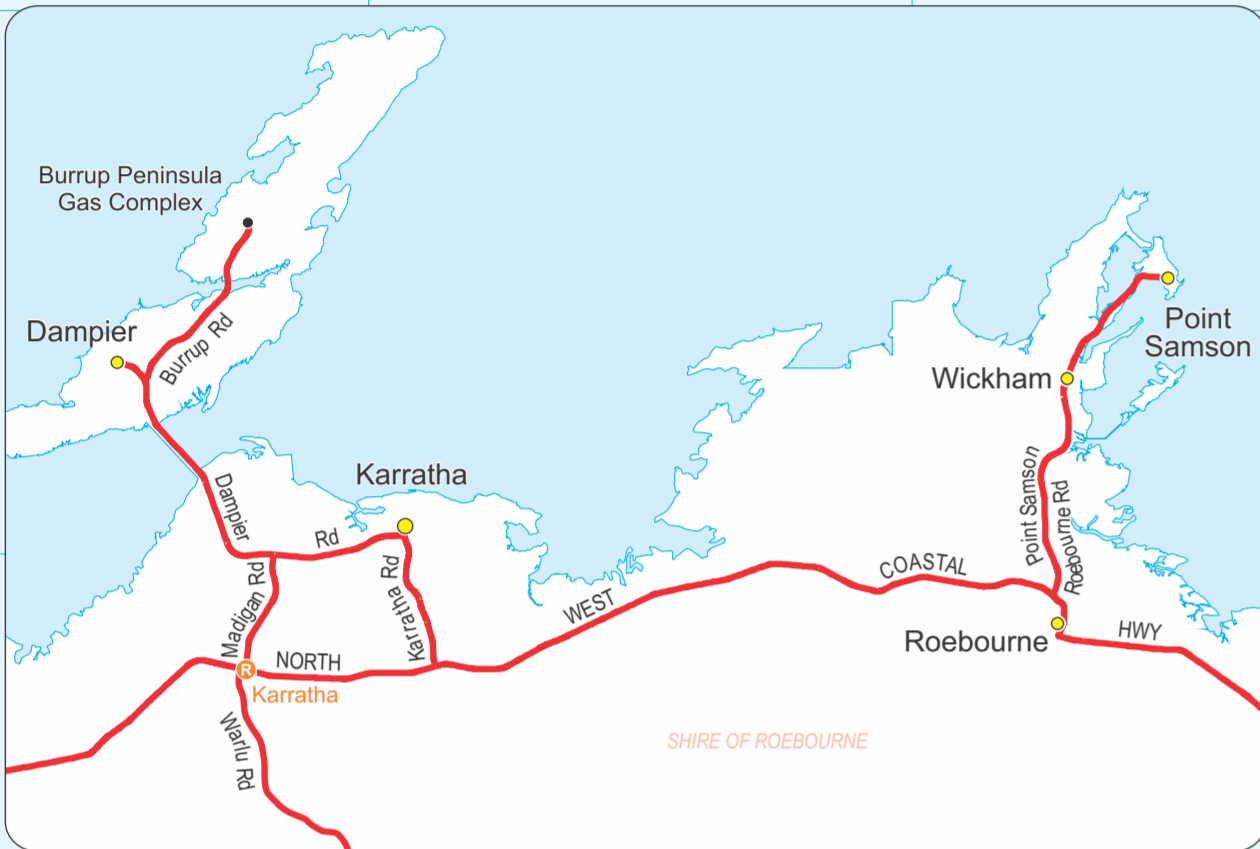

Many Minor Local Government Roads can be unsealed and only suitable for off-road vehicles. For further information please contact the respective Local Government.

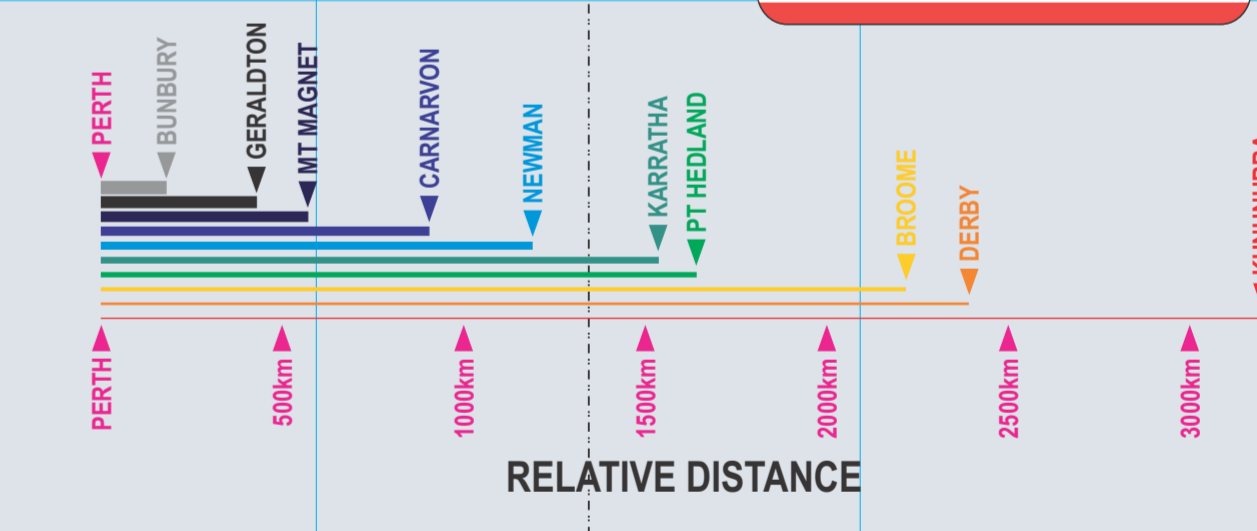
