The Engineering Cadetship program at Main Roads is designed to provide **University students studying Civil or Electrical engineering** with tuition fee support, paid vacation work and entry onto our Engineering Graduate Program upon successful completion of studies.

Your career at Main Roads

Our main goal is to help you grow. As a leader, as a thinker – and as an individual who has impact on our communities.

Main Roads is looking for enthusiastic, invested and courageous students who are interested in working in and around regional Western Australia. Our cadetship program offers the following:

Tuition Fee Support

As part of your Cadetship, Main Roads will pay the compulsory tuition fees directly to your university for your enrolled units at the beginning of each semester.

Paid Study (Sustenance Allowance)

To assist you in focusing on your full time studies, during semester Main Roads will pay you a fortnightly sustenance allowance, based on your current year of study.

Vacation Work

Over the summer break Main Roads will provide you with paid vacation employment, where you will gain hands-on practical experience participating in substantial engineering projects, technical specialist areas, or understanding network performance in our Road Network Operations Centre.

Your Commitment

You will need to be in your final or penultimate year of study next year, and commit to studying full time. In return for being supported through your studies, you will enter into a bond with Main Roads to work for us for at least two years (based on the length of your cadetship).

Study Complete!

Once you have successfully completed your degree, you join our Graduate Engineering Program. The three-year rotational program offers structured rotations including a 12-month regional rotation at any of our seven regional locations. - A copy of your current academic results in a Bachelor of Civil Engineering or Electrical or Electronic Engineering
- An up to date CV
- Cover Letter (refer to the job ad – we will ask you to write about some specific points)
- Proof of Australian citizenship or PR
- 'C' class Drivers Licence
- Face to face interview
- Cultural fit and willingness to work in the regions
