

Methodology

A survey was conducted with a random sample of 1,418 members of the public across Western Australia.

An online survey achieved **n=1,190** completed interviews, using Q&A's quality accredited WA online panel. In addition, **n=228** social media interviews were conducted to achieve the target sample of n=100 responses per region. The same survey was used for both online and social media. Some responses were removed in the data cleaning process.

All fieldwork was conducted from 27 February to 2 April 2023.

Soft quotas were set by age, gender and region. In line with previous surveys, the data was weighted by age, gender and region to reflect 2016 ABS Census statistics.

The **total sample** of **1,418** provides a maximum margin of error of \pm 2.6% at the 95% confidence interval.

The response rate for the social media component was **18%** and **14%** for online.

Question wording and analysis of data for KPI performance reporting remained entirely consistent with previous years.



KPI Ratings % Total Okay, Good and Excellent




Environmental and sustainability KPI ratings remain on par with last year






Overall performance softened in 2023 in both Metro and Regional ratings

Isolating regional and metropolitan ratings shows both returning to levels seen in 2018.




Overall Performance by Region




Road Safety by Region




Road Maintenance by Region
