
NOTES:

- 1. Minimum 4 Pilot vehicles required to facilitate contra flow movement.
- Direct UHF radio communication is to be maintained between Pilot vehicles, Oversize vehicle(s) and Traffic Escort vehicle (if applicable) at all times.
- 3. Pilot vehicles 1, 2 & 3 shall move to the locations shown and stop all traffic to allow the Oversize vehicle(s) to execute the contra flow manoeuvre:
 - Pilot vehicle 1 shall stop eastbound traffic prior to the off-ramp to Wilson Street;
 - Pilot vehicle 2 shall stop westbound traffic turning into the Wilson Street on-ramp;
 - Pilot vehicle 3 shall stop northbound traffic on Wilson Street Northbound until the Oversize vehicle(s) have progressed onto the off-ramp from Great Northern Highway.
- Oversize vehicle(s) shall not begin the contra flow maneuver until notified that all traffic is stopped and the ramp from Great Northern Highway is clear of traffic.
- 4. Once the Oversize vehicle(s) have passed the intersection for eastbound traffic from Great Northern Highway entering Wilson Street via ramp, Pilot Vehicle 2 shall release traffic and proceed to Location 2, then stop traffic at that location until the Oversize vehicle(s) have returned to the natural lane on Great Northern Highway westbound.
- 5. Once the Oversize vehicle(s) are traveling westbound on Great Northern Highway the Pilot vehicles can release traffic and continue with duties as required.
