In order to obtain the 36.5 metre Greenmount Hill Access Permit, participating 36.5 metre A-Doubles must meet all the eligibility requirements and provide evidence of such to Main Roads Heavy Vehicle Services. The 36.5 metre Greenmount Hill Access Permit Eligibility & Supporting Evidence Checklist is available on our website and must be submitted with your permit application.

You must also be a registered Operator with Main Roads WA. If you do not have an Operator Number, please complete the Restricted Access Vehicle Operator and WA Heavy Vehicle Accreditation Registration form, available on our website. Please ensure that all vehicles listed on this permit application have been registered with Main Roads. To register vehicles, please complete an Application to List or Update a Vehicle form for each motor vehicle, available on our website.

### Eligibility Requirements

Please check the box to confirm that all supporting evidence has been provided to address the eligibility criteria below.

1. Transporting the particular load by road must not compete with rail. As such, transport task details must be provided.
2. Drivers must have a minimum of 3 years of experience in driving road trains and a good driving record. A National Police Clearance is required to confirm the driver does not have any serious traffic convictions before they are approved on the permit.
3. The prime mover must be fitted with an Antilock Braking System (ABS) and Electronic Braking System (EBS) with compatible CAN connection.
4. The trailers must be fitted with a Trailer Electronic Braking System (TEBS) with a Rollover Stability System (RSS) and with a compatible CAN connection.
5. The prime mover must be fitted with an engine that meets the emission standards specified in the Vehicle Standard (Australian Design Rule 80/03 - Emission Control for Heavy Vehicles) 2006 (equivalent to Euro 5 Standards).
6. The prime movers must be fitted with a driver fatigue and distraction monitoring system, with appropriate governance in place to ensure events are managed effectively.
7. The prime mover(s) must be installed with an in-vehicle telematics unit and Main Roads Heavy Vehicle Services (HVS) must be provided direct access to the telematics monitoring system. The telematics service provider must provide weekly reports demonstrating all vehicles stop in the mandatory stopping bay at the top of Greenmount Hill to check brakes and descend at a speed of no more than 40 km/h.
8. The prime mover(s) must be fitted with and utilise an auxiliary braking system when descending the hill. Drivers must be familiar with the operation of the particular auxiliary braking system, with training records provided to HVS.
9. At least one forward facing camera and one rear-facing camera must be mounted on the prime mover and operate in accordance with the Restricted Access Vehicle Video Recording Requirements, available on the Specific Access Permits page on the Main Roads website. The rear-facing camera must be positioned on the driver's side of the prime mover.

**Note:** The 36.5 metre Greenmount Hill Access Permit Eligibility & Supporting Evidence Checklist, available on our website must be submitted with your permit application.

HVS receives reports from the nominated Service Provider that provide identifiable information including vehicle position, time and speed data that reports vehicle activity against permit conditions. Authorised Officers will have access to the information you provide for compliance and enforcement purposes. Your personal details will not be disclosed to any other third party without your consent unless required to do so by law or for purposes mentioned in the Information Privacy Act 2009.
