



Special Purpose Vehicle State-Wide Parameters Table

An operator of a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) within the mass and dimension limits specified in the tables below may be eligible for a State-Wide SPV period permit, subject to the route restrictions specified within the Special Purpose Vehicle Standard Operating Conditions. An SPV operating under a period permit must not cross a bridge listed as a restricted bridge where specified in the period permit.

*Note: All tyres fitted on an All-terrain Crane must be minimum 20.5 inch (508mm).
