The \$386.5 million Great Eastern Highway Bypass Interchanges project is jointly funded by the Australian Government (\$247.25 million), the State Government (\$128.22 million), the City of Swan and the City of Kalamunda.

Have your say on our latest design

The \$386.5 million Great Eastern Highway Bypass Interchanges project includes two new interchanges, widening of Roe Highway, the Lloyd Street Bridge link into Midland and upgrades to Abernethy Road. Upon completion in 2024, the project will enhance connectivity, relieve congestion, and improve safety in Perth's Eastern Metropolitan Region, bringing immediate benefits for over 60,000 road users per day.

Main Roads and the Greater Connect Alliance team are currently liaising with a range of key stakeholders to ensure the project design considers local community concerns and aspirations.

We are also keen to hear from local residents, businesses, and other interested community members to identify and understand local issues and opportunities as part of our design development process.

Feedback can be provided in three ways:

Project Update

In the past month, local community members and road users may have noticed some site investigation and survey activities along the road alignment on Abernethy Road, Great Eastern Highway Bypass and Roe Highway. These low-level, unobtrusive works are required to obtain ground water, rock and soil samples; and confirm site conditions and the location of underground services. The information obtained will inform the project design.

Next steps

Following review of community feedback on the project in September and October, detailed design will commence. Preparations for major construction works will also commence including service relocation works and installation of temporary road pavement in the median along Great Eastern Highway Bypass between Roe Highway and Abernethy Road. The temporary pavement will ensure continued traffic flow during construction of the new interchanges.
