



High Street Upgrade Stirling Highway to Carrington Street

Traffic changes near Fremantle Netball Association

In order to construct the High Street Upgrade project safely and with minimal impacts to traffic, a number of local access changes are currently in place.

During the netball season, it is likely that there will be further changes to traffic configuration. We will continue to keep the Fremantle Netball Association up to date during this period, and changes will be shared via the Association's social media channels.

The following traffic measures are currently in place:

- No access to southern High Street verge – this now forms part of the construction area and for safety reasons this area is not accessible
- No right turns to or from High Street between Stirling Highway and Carrington Street.
- Left turn access only onto High Street between Stirling Highway and Carrington Street.
- Access to and from High Street at Montreal Street is closed until September.
- Stirling Highway near Marmion Street has been realigned to facilitate pedestrian underpass construction at Forrest Street.
- No right turn from Marmion Street eastbound to Stirling Highway southbound.
- High Street near Carrington Street has been realigned.
- Traffic management and speed reductions are in place in the area, particularly on High Street and Stirling Highway, please drive with care, and allow extra travel time.
