

Karel Avenue Upgrade Project Update

The Karel Avenue Upgrade project is progressing to schedule, with a contract for design and construction to be awarded in February 2019

Additional Scope Confirmed

We are pleased to advise that the scope of the project has recently been extended, following funding contributions from the City of Cockburn and Jandakot Airport Holdings. In addition to widening and extending the existing Karel Avenue Bridge over Roe Highway and the freight railway line, the project now comprises:

1. Widening the section of Karel Avenue between Roe Highway and Farrington Road to two lanes in each direction.
2. Widening the section of Karel Avenue between Roe Highway and the Berrigan Drive roundabout to two lanes in each direction.

Upon completion, these additions will:

- Remove a frustrating and potentially dangerous bottleneck south of Farrington Road, where two lanes currently merge into one.
- Provide additional congestion relief for Leeming and Bull Creek residents,
- Improve access to the Jandakot Light Industrial Area and support further development of the Jandakot Airport Precinct.

Dimond Court Update

Following discussions with the City of Cockburn and local residents living to the east of Karel Avenue, a new U-turn facility will be provided on Karel Avenue south of Dimond Court.

This addition, which includes a turning pocket, will improve safety and relieve pressure on right-turn traffic movements from Dimond Court, particularly during peak hours.

Construction of the project is expected to begin in early 2019 following a period of detailed design.

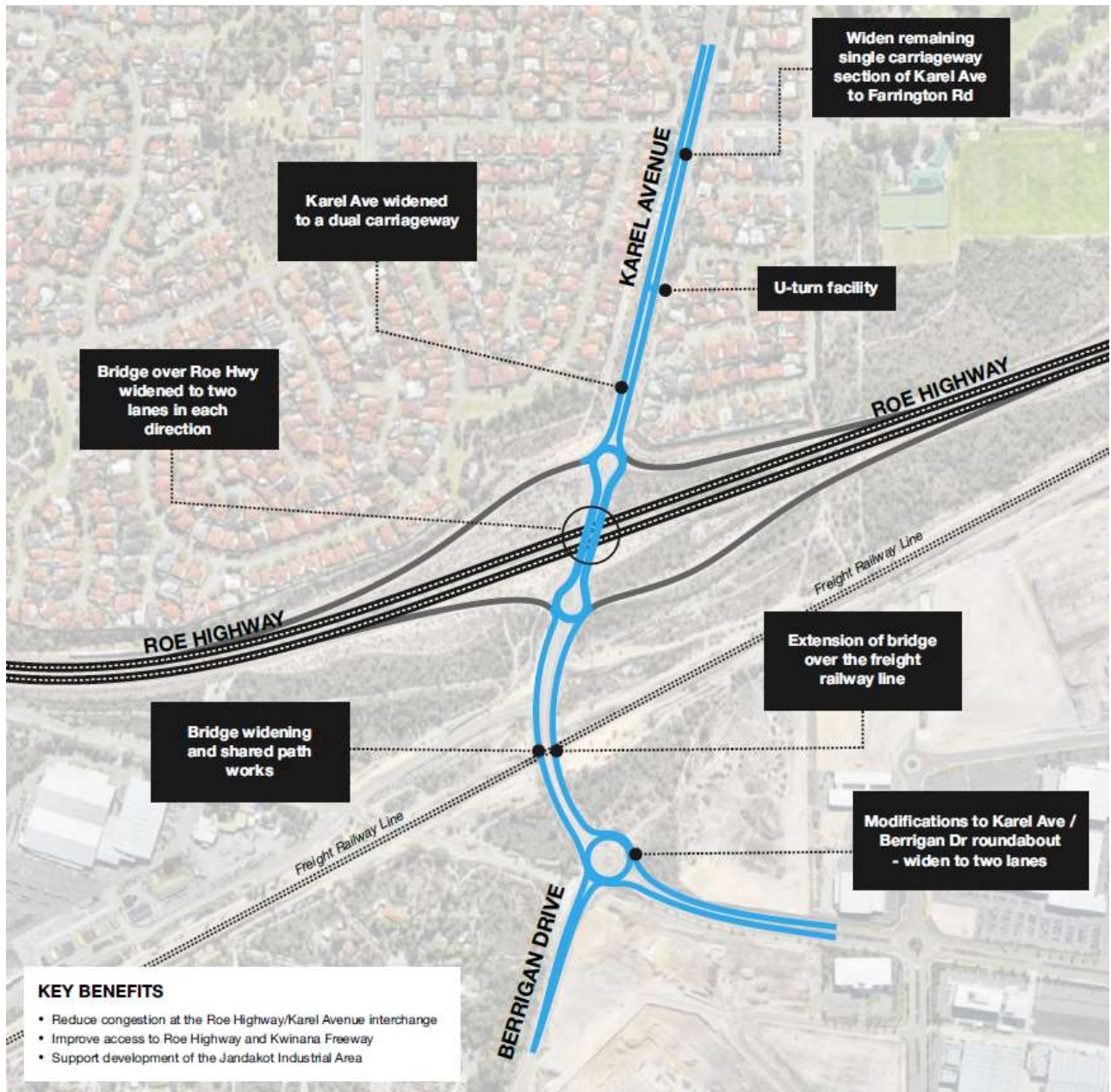


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Final concept design (November 2018)



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
