How works may affect you

What is happening?

Early works, including earthworks, are underway as construction activities commence. We are also conducting compaction trials to optimise our use of equipment adjacent to properties.

How will you be affected?

You may notice additional heavy vehicle traffic while we transport fill associated with the new bridge.

There will also be traffic changes including speed reductions, lane closures on Welshpool Road and lane narrowing on Leach Highway.

After hours work scheduled for June

Out of hours activities will occur on Leach Highway and Welshpool Road, between Orrong Road and Albany Highway, including:

- Kerb removal
- New road line markings
- Temporary road barrier installation and pavement works
- Vegetation clearing

Service relocations

Night works involve small crews with vehicles, mostly on the road verge. While impacts should be minimal, the following may be experienced:

- Out of hours works between 7pm and 7am
- Traffic management, when required

What mitigation measures will be in place?

Comprehensive management plans are in place for dust, noise, and vibration monitoring.
