Reid Highway Interchanges Project

Early site investigation works underway

The Reid Highway Interchanges Project will upgrade two of the remaining 5 signalised intersections along Reid Highway at Altone Road and Drumpellier Drive/Daviot Road to improve safety, reduce congestion and support future growth in the area.

Georgiou Group, on behalf of Main Roads, is preparing to undertake early works ahead of major construction, which is scheduled to begin in late 2025.

Early site investigations are now underway to inform detailed design and construction planning.

What to expect

- **Start date:** Early August 2025
- **Duration:** Approximately four weeks
- **Working hours:** Monday to Friday, 7am – 5pm (some after-hours works will be required).
- **Activities:** Site investigations including soil testing, ground condition assessments, utility locating, water monitoring and surveying.

While minimal noise, dust or vibration is expected, there will be an increase in activity along the road corridor and surrounding areas. You may notice workers and vehicles accessing different locations throughout the project area.

Upcoming traffic management

You will soon start to see temporary traffic management in place on Reid Highway and surrounding roads to support early investigation works.

Daytime works from 11 August to late-August

This will include speed limits along Reid Highway, and at the Altone Road and Drumpellier Drive / Daviot Road intersections reduced intermittently over the next four weeks.

We will also be working along sections of the Principal Shared Path (PSP), with measures in place to ensure safe access for path users.

Daytime works are planned from 11 to 15 August and 25 to 29 August.

After hours works from 18 to 22 August

We are required to access the Reid Highway median as part of our site investigation works. This will require partial lane closures during the night to create a safe buffer zone for crews, while minimising disruption to daytime traffic. We anticipate minimal noise, dust and vibration impacts during these works. If you have any concerns during the works, please contact **138 138** (24 hours).

Noise wall planning

As part of the Reid Highway Interchanges Project, new noise walls will be installed along sections of the corridor to reduce road traffic noise and improve amenity for nearby residents.

Noise walls and other noise mitigations will be delivered in accordance with State Planning Policy 5.4 – Road and Rail Noise, which sets out noise level targets and technical requirements for major transport projects in Western Australia.

We will be commencing noise monitoring and survey works at selected locations over the coming weeks. These works will help identify where noise walls are required and determine their optimal height and location.

Some properties may require access to complete this monitoring. If property access is required, the project team will contact you directly to arrange a suitable time.

Precondition surveys

Prior to construction works starting, pre-condition surveys will be offered to properties located within 100 metres of the project boundary.

We encourage all property owners to complete these surveys, to establish the condition of your properties and structures that may be impacted by construction activities. Eligible properties will be contacted directly to organise a survey.

Community engagement

A dedicated contractor engagement team is in place for the project. Over the coming weeks, the team will be connecting with community members, local businesses and other stakeholders to answer questions, provide updates and gather feedback.

Community drop-in sessions are being planned to provide an opportunity to meet the project team and learn more about the project. Details will be shared shortly through upcoming project communications and on the project webpage.
