## **Swan River Crossings Project Update**



# Time to delve into design

The time has arrived for community and stakeholders to put forward their views on the design aspects of the Swan River Crossings Project at Fremantle.

The \$230 million project will replace the Fremantle Traffic Bridge, upgrade rail infrastructure, and transform cycling and pedestrian paths while also improving navigational safety for boats on the Derbarl Yerrigan (Swan River).

Interested stakeholders and the broader community are encouraged to download the <u>Design Inspiration document</u> <u>here</u>, which has been created as a community resource setting out key themes about place, history, and people. The document was developed in collaboration with Whadjuk Nyoongar Elders who have provided traditional knowledge about Walyalup (Fremantle) and continue to advise the project through a Whadjuk Elders Advisory Group.

After reviewing the document, an online <u>Design Survey here</u>, is available for people to put forward ideas on how the new infrastructure might look and feel in the future.

During our last survey we received feedback from nearly 1000 community members which influenced the Swan River Crossings bridge alignment decision.
