

Wanneroo Road and Joondalup Drive Interchange

Construction Update

Ongoing works at Cheriton Drive, Clarkson Avenue and the Wanneroo Road and Joondalup Drive intersection

Works at Cheriton Drive

April to July 2020



Works to upgrade the intersection at Cheriton Drive and Joondalup Drive into a roundabout has commenced. Once complete, the new roundabout will provide local residents and patrons of the Carramar Shopping Centre and community facilities with safer, more efficient access to and from Cheriton Drive.

Works are currently being undertaken on the northern side of Joondalup Drive and on Cheriton Drive.

Activities include:

- New drainage and underground services installation
- Earthworks, including pavement construction and resurfacing
- Kerbing, footpaths and landscaping
- Lighting, signs and line marking

Traffic management is in place between Houghton Drive and 100m east of The Duke to safely guide traffic through the construction area. Once construction on the northern side of Joondalup Drive is complete, works on the southern side will be undertaken. This will occur mid-May and involve switching traffic to the newly constructed northern carriageways in a similar contra-flow arrangement as is currently present.

Upcoming works at Clarkson Avenue

April to July 2020

Works at the Clarkson Avenue and Wanneroo Road intersection have begun with traffic barriers installed and some temporary lane closures in place. Drainage and pavement works in the median on Wanneroo Road have commenced, as well as preparatory works for a new fourth leg of the Clarkson Avenue, which will ultimately provide an additional connection to the Drovers Business Precinct.

Some intermittent night time closures of Clarkson Avenue are required to install traffic barriers and carry out pavement works. Drivers are encouraged to slow down and obey speed limits and follow the detour signage. Activities will include:

- Clearing and vegetation removal
- Temporary traffic barrier installation
- New drainage and underground services installation and relocations
- Earthworks, including pavement construction and resurfacing
- Kerbing, footpaths and landscaping
- Lighting, signs and line marking
- Traffic signal installation

In addition to the traffic management currently in place, both lanes of Clarkson Avenue will be pushed to the north to allow pavement works and service relocations to be undertaken. All current turning movements will remain however speed limits will be reduced to 40km/hr.

Pedestrians will still be able to safely cross Clarkson Avenue with fencing and temporary traffic barriers clearly indicating the route. Those wishing to cross Wanneroo Road will need to follow the detour north to the Drovers Marketplace. Please follow detour signage and only cross at designated crossing locations.



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Progress on the bridge

Bridge works at the main intersection continue to be major focus. Construction of the ramp walls are underway with the eastern walls nearing completion and the installation of drainage infrastructure and the backfilling of the ramps has commenced. Installation of precast traffic barriers and pavement works on the bridge will start in early April.

Out of hours work

Some out of hours works will be required to reduce the construction timeframe and lessen the overall impact to the community. Out of hours works may be undertaken during the following times*:

- **Intermittent Sundays between 5 April and 31 May, 8am to 5pm**
- **Public holidays: Friday 10 April, Monday 13 April and Monday 27 April, 9am to 5pm**
- **Monday to Saturday on intermittent nights between 4 April and 30 May, 7pm to 7am**

Works undertaken out of hours will include:

- Locating and marking underground services
- Modifying line-marking, barriers and signage
- Profiling existing pavement
- Verge, pavement and topsoil removal
- Installing drainage including road crossings
- Pavement construction
- Installing precast bridge barriers
- Backfilling of bridge ramps

These works and vehicle movements throughout the area may be noticeable to nearby residents, however every effort will be made to reduce construction noise and vibration where possible. New micro-vibe rollers have been sourced and deployed which reduce the amount of vibration adjacent to the works. To minimise disturbance to residents as much as possible, an out-of-hours noise management plan has been prepared by CPB Contractors and approved by the City of Wanneroo.

Please proceed with caution at all times and adhere to the speed limit and directional signage throughout the area. Please plan ahead and allow extra travel time as delays may occur.

**Please note that these are projected timeframes and are subject to change due to weather and/or other factors. Regular updates will be posted on the Main Roads website and emailed to those subscribed to project updates. Where applicable, Variable Message Sign Boards on site will provide up-to-date information.*

Other intersection works

Pre-works have commenced on the Burns Beach Road roundabout. More information about these works will be available in the coming weeks.
