

Wanneroo Road and Joondalup Drive Interchange Construction Update

Works to start on Clarkson Avenue and Wanneroo Road intersection

Construction works are due to start this month on the upgrade of the Clarkson Avenue and Wanneroo Road intersection to traffic lights. Once works are complete, the new intersection will include signalised pedestrian crossings, dedicated right hand turn lanes and arrows, and a tie-in leg for the developers of the commercial property along Wanneroo Road (south of the Drovers Precinct).

Initial works

Pre-construction works include underground service locating, fencing and barrier installation, and line-marking removal.

Stage One works

Stage One of construction will begin during the week commencing Monday 17 February 2020 and last for approximately two months. This will involve the installation of barriers along Wanneroo Road southbound, and Clarkson Avenue near the Wanneroo Road intersection. Once these barriers are installed, these sections of the roads will be reduced to one lane. However, the roads will remain open, there will be no detours during Stage One.

Works will involve:

- Clearing and removing verges and vegetation
- Earthworks including pavement removal and new pavement construction
- Installing drainage and underground services
- Installing kerbing and footpaths



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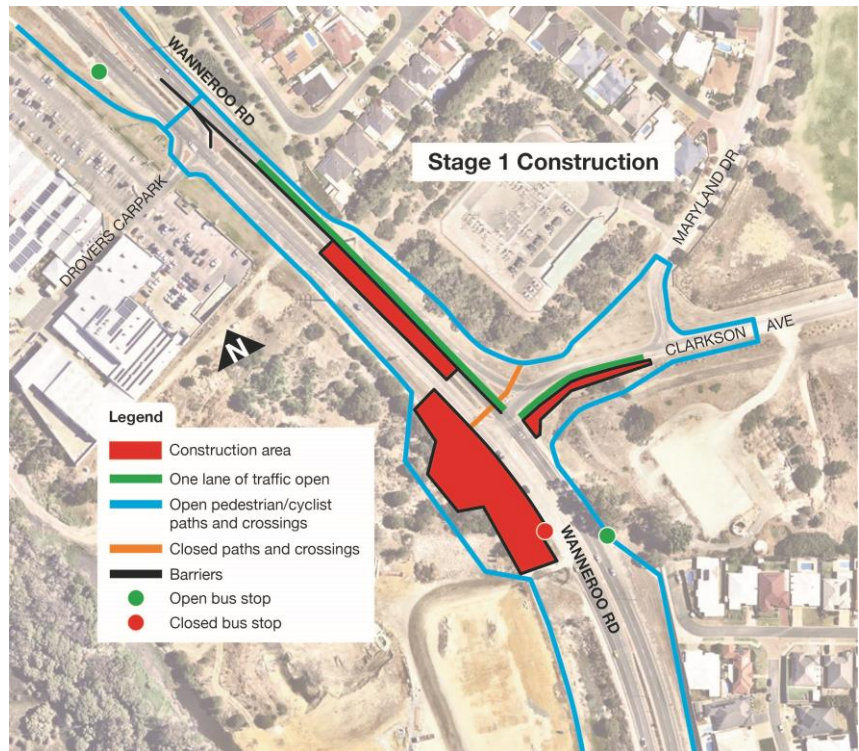
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What to expect

- All roads will remain open
- Sections of Wanneroo Road and Clarkson Avenue will be reduced to one lane.
- The bus stop on the west side of Wanneroo Road will be temporarily closed.
- Pedestrians and cyclists will still have access through the area via the detoured paths.

Stage Two works

The next stage will focus on working on the other side of the barriers, which involves constructing new roads, median strips and installing traffic lights. Information about this stage of works will be communicated closer to the time.



Out of hours work

Some out of hours works will be required as crews will be working on the road which will require lane closures. By working at night we can reduce disruption to road users and works can be completed in the shortest possible timeframe. Works will be undertaken on intermittent nights.

The following out of hours work may be undertaken

- Sundays 23 February, 1 March, 8 March, 15 March.
- Monday 17 February to Saturday 14 March 2020, 7pm to 7am

How long will works take?

- Stage One works should take up to two months to complete
- The intersection should be complete mid-2020.
