New works to start in 2020

The Wanneroo Road and Joondalup Drive Interchange project is on track for completion in mid-2020.

Early in the new year, works will commence in various new areas across the project site.

Our team will break for Christmas from Friday 20 December 2019 and return on Thursday 2 January 2020.

Security will be on site providing monitoring services during this period.

Wanneroo Road/Joondalup Drive bridge

At the bridge location, the backfilling of ramps will continue until the Christmas break.

Works will also start to install concrete walls along the top of the ramp walls to reinforce the strength of the ramps.

Along the section of Joondalup Drive heading eastbound towards the bridge, sealing works will be finished and asphalt will be laid, with planned completion by the end of 2019.

Reinforcement for the bridge deck will continue into the new year and works will then focus on pouring the 200mm concrete deck, which will start in January.

At this time, traffic will be moved further north on Joondalup Drive approaching the roundabout.

This will allow the remaining mechanically stabilised earth (MSE) to be installed and the ramp filled.



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Cheriton Drive/Joondalup Drive roundabout

Early next year will see the start of works at Cheriton Drive to install a new roundabout at the intersection of Joondalup Drive.

Works will start in January with grading and preparation of the sub-base. Further works will include upgrading the drainage system and resurfacing the road.

More information about the traffic management of this area will be provided in early 2020.



Clarkson Avenue and Burns Beach Road



Improvements will be made to the roundabout at the intersection of Burns Beach Road and Joondalup Drive and a new signalised intersection will be created at Clarkson Avenue and Wanneroo Road. Works in these two locations is also scheduled to start early in the new year.

Out of Hours

Some out of hours works will be required to ensure construction can be carried out safely and with minimal disruption to traffic. More details will be provided, but please be aware that out of hours works may be undertaken from 7pm to 7am on Monday 16 December to Friday 20 December 2019, and during January 2020.
