

Albany Ring Road Project

Advanced notice of South Coast Highway and Hanrahan Road / Frenchman Bay Road traffic changes

Construction of the major Albany Ring Road interchanges at South Coast Highway and at Hanrahan Road / Frenchman Bay Road are making good progress, with significant earthworks underway. The next stage of construction will require several traffic changes over an extended period. These changes will be implemented from January 2023 until mid-2024.

Minor detours and deviations are planned in these locations that will impact journeys between Albany and Denmark and along Frenchman Bay Road.

Hanrahan Road / Frenchman Bay Road - January 2023 to 2024

In recent months, a temporary road layout has been constructed adjacent to Frenchman Bay Road to accommodate traffic during the next phase of construction and to separate road users from site activities. This layout will become operational in January 2023. Access between Lower Denmark Road and Princess Royal Drive / Hanrahan Road for cyclists and road users will be via a loop along Frenchman Bay Road and Woolstores Place.

The new layout will be signed, and a sealed two-metre shoulder will be provided for cyclists and pedestrians. The speed limit through the works area will be reduced and road users should allow extra travel time during peak travel periods.

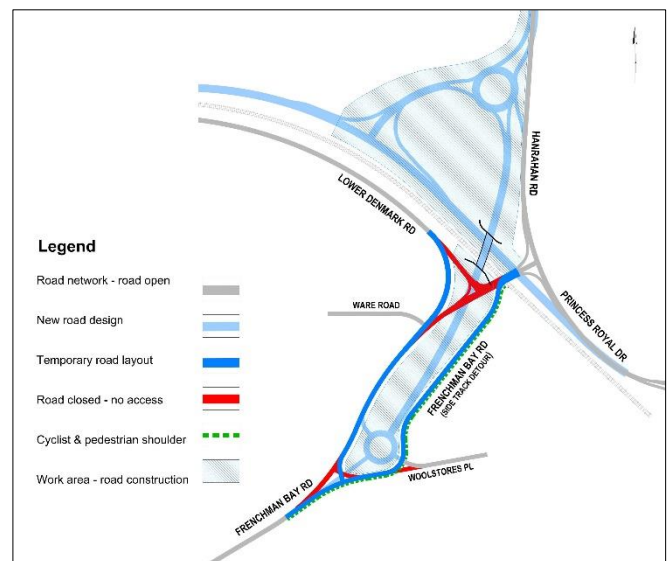


Figure 1: Temporary road layout: Hanrahan Road / Frenchman Bay Road

South Coast Highway and Link Road temporary alignment - February 2023 to 2024

We thank residents and road users for their patience while the section of Link Road between Lancaster Road and South Coast Highway has been closed. This section of road will reopen to traffic from February 2023.

The next stage of work in this location includes the excavation of part of South Coast Highway and construction of a new bridge over the Albany Ring Road. To keep traffic moving during this period a temporary realignment of South Coast Highway will be implemented in February 2023. Light vehicles and cyclists along South Coast Highway will be diverted to a temporary alignment

immediately north of the existing highway. This temporary alignment will remain in place until the new interchange is operational in 2024.

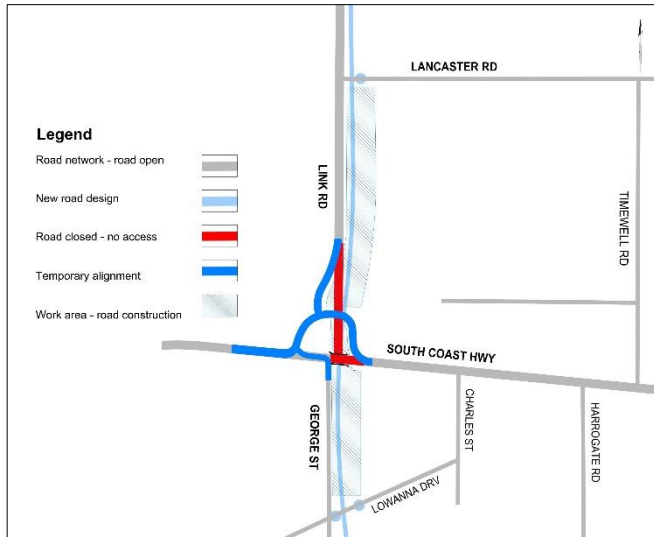


Figure 2: Temporary road layout: South Coast Highway

What this means for road users

A temporary speed limit of 40km/h will be in place throughout the works. Please proceed with caution, allow additional journey time where possible and be aware of the changes to the road layout.

Access to businesses will be maintained and signposted during construction.
