





Albany Ring Road Project

Access between Roundhay Street, Lower Denmark Road and the Albany Ring Road

The construction of the Albany Ring Road project necessitates a number of access changes between Roundhay Street, Lower Denmark Road and the Albany Ring Road.

Access between Roundhay Street and Lower Denmark Road will be **temporarily closed during October 2023** to allow for construction of a new intersection of Roundhay Street and the Albany Ring Road.

It is anticipated that direct access between Roundhay Street and Lower Denmark Road will be **permanently removed from February 2024** due to the closure of the freight rail level crossing (see map below).

Connectivity for road users

During October 2023 and from February 2024 through to the opening of the Albany Ring Road, a temporary cul-de-sac will be in place on Roundhay Street to the north of the rail crossing. During these periods, access to Roundhay Street will be available via South Coast Highway and Balston Road.

Access between Allerton Street and Lower Denmark Road is unaffected.

Upon completion of the project, road users will be able to access Roundhay Street from the Albany Ring Road in both an eastbound and westbound direction (see map overleaf).




Figure 1: Access changes during construction








Figure 2: Access between Roundhay Street, Albany Ring Road and Lower Denmark Road following completion of the Albany Ring Road project
