



This update contains information regarding the current and future works happening on the Bunbury Outer Ring Road (BORR) project. Project update

Construction of the Bunbury Outer Ring Road (BORR) is now 48 per cent complete, and on track to hit 50 per cent completion next month.

There has been significant activity recently at the 'mega-bridge' construction site, including concrete pours for some of the bridge columns and the collision wall. In total, there are 11 piers and 33 columns at this bridge, which takes BORR over Golding Crescent, the Ferguson River, the freight rail line, and Boyanup-Picton Road. When finished, this bridge will be an impressive 382 metres, making it the longest bridge in the South West.

At the Raymond Road interchange, the bridge is further taking shape, with the team completing the installation of balustrades along both sides. Pedestrian balustrades are installed along bridges to ensure the safety of all pedestrians utilising the footpath. Next, the guardrails will be installed, which will support vehicles travelling over the bridge.
