





Environmental Update

- The purpose of the environmental reports for BORR south, Red Corridor and Green Corridor is to describe their environmental values and the potential impact the construction and operation of the BORR may have on these values and not for the purpose of attaining environmental approval.
- The Reports are entitled Environmental Impact Assessments, (EIA's)
- The EIA's are not the final documents referred to the EPA as the detail will need to be refined for the final chosen alignment.
- The EIA's will inform the broader report in preparation to determine the preferred alignment.


