



Improvements to the State Road Traffic Management Company Registration Scheme

We are continuing to implement improvements to the pay and conditions for traffic management personnel working on State Roads.

Re-Registration Reminder

Companies wishing to retain their Main Roads Scheme registration must reapply to the Scheme under the new Conditions of Registration.

Due to a high volume of applications, we recommend you reapply to the scheme no later than **30 May 2024**. Main Roads will process incoming applications and issue Certificates of Registration to companies that are compliant with the Scheme.

Any company not registered by 1 July 2024 will not be permitted to perform work on any State controlled road or undertake traffic management directly or indirectly for Main Roads. **This includes any work undertaken for the Office of Major Transport Infrastructure Delivery (OMTID).**

Common Registration Issues

During the assessment of applications, the Registration Team have identified a few common application errors.

To assist in clarifying requirements, we have provided some guidance, as follows:

Section 7 (Supplying Traffic Management Plans)

There are **two methods** of demonstrating experience when supplying TMPs as part of your application:

1. Supply five site-specific TMPs which include:
 - a. Lane Closure
 - b. Aftercare scenario
 - c. Path user management plan
 - d. Reverse flow plan involving end of queue protection
 - e. Long-term works (site specific project greater than 14 days duration)OR
2. Supply five Complex TMPs (these are RTM endorsed).

All TMPs submitted as part of your application must have been implemented by the applicant.

Section 9 (Personnel Traffic Management Accreditation)

Please check the accreditation type of **all** personnel being listed as WTM or AWTM holders. Only WTM and/or AWTM personnel should be listed in this section, BWTM and/or TC holders do not need to be listed in this section.

State wide Traffic Management Panel. Note all companies who have not re-registered to the scheme under the new Conditions of Registration have had their expiry dates reset to **30 June 2024**.

Changes to minimum insurance requirements

Main Roads now requires traffic management companies to provide evidence of Professional Indemnity insurance coverage to the value of \$1 million. Under the previous prerequisites of the application form this requirement was \$5 million. The minimum cover level for Public Liability insurance remains at \$20,000,000.
