



KIMBERLEY FLOOD UPDATE



Two-lane low-level crossing now open!

A new, sealed, two-lane low-level crossing across the Fitzroy River, at Fitzroy Crossing, is now open!

The crossing, located approximately 200 metres upstream from the flood damaged bridge, forms part of a temporary detour of Great Northern Highway. It will be in operation over the dry season while the new bridge is being constructed.

The crossing is open to all vehicles, including road trains and oversize vehicles, at all times. A footpath is also being established to provide safe access for pedestrians.

The single-lane causeway across the Fitzroy River remains open to all vehicles up to Rigid Heavy Vehicles.

Ferry, barge and bus services stopped

With the opening of both the single and two-lane low-level crossings across the river, all ferry, barge and bus services have now ceased.

It is anticipated services will recommence operation during the next wet season.

New Fitzroy River Bridge

Removal of the bridge from the river is effectively complete. The piers have been cut off at a level which will allow the new ones to be constructed in a timely manner. The bridge team will come back later to remove them.

Construction of the new bridge will commence in June.
